5 Title I Parent Involvement

7 Letters of student selection into the Title I program will be sent to parents at the beginning of the
8 school year. Parent orientation meetings will be held in October to explain the Title I program,
9 offer opportunity for parents to ask questions or make suggestions, and provide a chance for
10 parents to meet Title I staff.

11
12 Parent workshops will be offered throughout the school year, as the need arises. These
13 workshops will address concerns and interest expressed by parents from surveys conducted at the
14 fall meeting. The Title I coordinator will be available to speak to parent groups in the District
15 and also be available upon request to speak to parent groups in private or Christian schools.

17 Title I programs will always be open for parents to drop in to discuss concerns. Upon request of
18 the building principal, Title I staff will be available for parent-teacher conferences.

20 A Title I newsletter will be distributed to parents, designed especially to inform Title I parents
21 about the Title I program. Parent surveys will be sent during April to allow the parent input in
22 the needs assessment for the following school year and to be part of program evaluation for the
23 current year.

25 It is the Board philosophy that after-school tutoring is in the best interest of the students.
26 Therefore, budgeting and scheduling of staff should be completed to meet this goal, by offering
27 after-school sessions in addition to our regular program.
