7 The Board has expressed its desire to form a firm partnership with the school community, in both  
8 Policy 1611, Philosophy, Goals, and Objectives, and Policy 1441, Audience Participation. The  
9 Board will support administration in goal planning for the community relations program and in  
10 efforts to provide in-service training for District employees with regard to school-community  
11 communications.

12  
13 The Superintendent will establish and maintain a communication process within the school  
14 system and between it and the community. Such public information program will provide for  
15 news releases at appropriate times, arrange for media coverage of district programs and events,  
16 provide for regular direct communications between individual schools and the citizens they  
17 serve, and assist staff in improving their skills and understanding in communicating with the  
18 public.

20 Citizen Advisory Committee

21  
22 The trustees recognize that issues occasionally arise, which result in an unusual amount of  
23 interest from the community. In such instances the Board may form a citizen's advisory  
24 committee, which will include as members, representatives from as broad a segment of the  
25 community as feasible.
