7 The Board of Trustees, School District 1, St. Regis Public Schools, has determined, through  
8 reasonable and prudent consideration, that students enrolled in the St. Regis High School may  
9 participate in an MHSА sanctioned high school varsity or junior varsity football program when at  
10 least twelve (12) or more St. Regis High School students indicated interest and register for  
11 participation in an MHSА sanctioned high school varsity or junior varsity football program.  
12

13 The Board of Trustees, School District 1, St. Regis Public Schools, has further determined,  
14 through reasonable and prudent consideration, that at least twelve (12) St. Regis High School  
15 varsity or junior varsity football players must maintain academic and physical eligibility in order  
16 to continue active team participation in an MHSА sanctioned varsity or junior varsity football  
17 program.

19 The Board of Trustees, School District 1, St. Regis Public Schools, further agrees that the  
20 administrators and coaches of School District 1 may, under certain conditions, permit St. Regis  
21 High School students to participate in a specific MHSА sanctioned varsity or junior varsity  
22 football contest when less than twelve, but no less than ten (10) St. Regis High School football  
23 players are academically or physically eligible; it is recognized that extenuating circumstances  
24 may warrant some discretionary authority. The final decision, based on extenuating  
25 circumstances warranting discretionary action, will rest with the head coach of the St. Regis High  
26 School varsity or junior varsity football program; and, that decision will only be rendered after  
27 reasonable and prudent professional judgment has be exercised in considering the nature of the  
28 extenuating circumstances.
