5 Cafeteria Visitation and Fees

7 In conjunction with the District's belief that all community members are welcome in the school,
8 all community members may visit during school time and eat a meal with the students. In order
9 to maintain accountability standards set by the federal government, a separate fund account will
10 be designated for this purpose.

12 To maintain educational focus for the children attending school, the following administrative
13 procedures will be followed:

15 1. Visitors are asked to give the District office notice of their intent to have breakfast or
16 lunch at school. This allows accurate planning and preparation of food to be served.

18 2. All visitors to the schools will need to check in to pick up a visit's identification badge to
19 be worn for the duration of the visit. Upon completion of the visit, the visitor will return
20 the identification badge.

22 3. Administration (Superintendent/principal) has discretion to revoke this attendance
23 privilege of any parent, guardian, and/or community member whose conduct, presence, or
24 frequency of participation may in any way conflict with a safe, orderly, and productive
25 working/learning environment for all District students.
